His expertise encompasses Territorial and Maritime disputes (including land boundary claims and maritime delimitation); Jurisdiction and Immunities; Treaty Law, Law of International Responsibility; International Human Rights Law; Law of Armed Conflict and Dispute Resolution.

He has also co-edited several books, including *The Oxford Handbook of Jurisdiction in International Law* (OUP, 2019); *The Rights of Indigenous Peoples in Marine Areas* (Hart, 2019); *Fifty Years of the British Indian Ocean Territory: Legal Perspectives* (Springer, 2018); and *Reflections on the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples* (Hart, 2011).
